



## Endangered Planet Foundation Announces 20th Anniversary and Next Chapter of One Earth | One Dream

Laguna Beach, California — June 1, 2026 — Endangered Planet Foundation (EPF) is celebrating its **20th Anniversary** while focusing on global collaboration, environmental stewardship, the arts, and **The Culture of Peace** initiatives through its expanding **One Earth | One Dream** platform.

The anniversary year will feature **EPF's** collaboration with the **Global Flagship of Peace — Odyssey**, including its **June 8, 2026, inauguration in Manila, Philippines**, and a documentary highlighting the vessel's mission, partnerships, and cultural impact through the **Art Miles Mural Project**. Odyssey marks a new chapter in **EPF's** work to unite artists, educators, environmental advocates, communities, and leaders around a shared vision for the planet.

Over the past two decades, **EPF** has advanced environmental awareness through collaborations with **The Art Miles Mural Project** and founders **Joanne and Fouad Tawfilis**, environmental speakers, and **Earth Day** founder **John McConnell** – using public art, education, media, community events, Town Hall meetings, and **Earth Day** and other **proclamations** to inspire stewardship and planetary responsibility.

Among its milestone achievements, **EPF** produced two **One Earth | One Dream** Festivals in Laguna Beach, including one at **The Festival of Arts**, uniting environmental speakers, artists, and community leaders around sustainability, peace, and planetary responsibility.

Founded in 2006 on Main Beach in Laguna Beach, **EPF** began with a 2005 **American Red Cross** fundraiser supporting **Hurricane Katrina** relief. Since then, **EPF** has advanced environmental awareness and humanitarian action through programs, events, education, public art, and community partnerships.
